

I am pleased to launch this year's Enrichment Week commencing on 17th July and finishing on 19th July. 

Pupil Premium - An Explanation

As you read through the booklet, you will notice that the courses have different costs for students who are eligible for the Pupil Premium grant. As with all trips during the school year, Pupil Premium funding is used to subsidise activities, reducing the cost for disadvantaged students. This allows students to access opportunities that they might not otherwise have the chance to be involved in.

Each course has been given a percentage subsidy and this differs between each course as this is based on the relative benefit of each activity. For example, a course which has more potential to benefit a child's academic achievement or personal development will receive a higher subsidy than other, less academic, courses.

Art and Animals



Course outline:

This course is designed for students with a love of either Art and/or Textiles.


Day 1: Trip to Port Lympne Zoo to draw animals and go on the safari experience! Here we will gain inspiration from a range of exotic animals ready to bring back to the art rooms and experiment with a range of art and textiles techniques.

Day 2: Group 1 will explore animal features and patterns using a range of mixed media techniques in Art. Group 2 will explore a range of techniques using materials in textiles.

Day 3: The groups will switch so group 1 will experiment using a range of textiles techniques and group 2 will explore using a mixed media art techniques.


During the week, students will;

- Hand sewing/embroidery to finish items and embellish others.

Students will have an opportunity to combine skills and, if more experienced, can learn how to follow a pattern to make another small item (cupcakes, jellyfish, panda...).

<u>Day 1</u> - <u>Mixed media</u>. You will use mixed media techniques to make and decorate a square MDF box and lid. You will add texture and pre-cut shapes before adding a layer of powertex to make the decoration more hardwearing. The box will then be decorated with acrylic paint and dry brushing techniques (look at the guitar in room 217 to see similar mixed media effects with powertex).

<u>Day 2</u> - <u>Journal making</u>. You will be making a journal from scratch using greyboard and patterned paper. The journal will contain pocket sleeves made from envelopes and hold an A6 paper pad. Once completed the pocket sleeves will be decorated with patterned paper and additional printed designs. You will learn how to create a professional look!

<u>Day 3</u> - <u>Mini folded book</u>. You will create a folded book using card that will be attached to a hard cover. You will make your own front and back cover design with water colour paper, coffee filters, crayola pens and a bit of zentangle thrown in!

If you like to make things and enjoy being creative this is the course for you!

Tough climbs will be rewarded with stunning views of the South Downs and its surrounding human and physical landscapes.

Students will complete the hike in three stages with return transport from Ratton each morning and evening from the start and end points.

NB: The cost for this course is used to cover transport to the start point each day.

- Students will have the opportunity to develop **resilience** as they overcome the challenges of three full days' hiking over sometimes difficult terrain.
- New friends can be made as they work as a **team** with students they may not have met before as they all help **motivate** each other to complete the challenge.
- Students will have the opportunity to experience the sense of freedom gained from outdoor learning and the enjoyment of nature as they are immersed in the beautiful South Down landscapes right on our doorstep.
