Module Title	Module Overview
Pole to Pole	Students will learn what influences climate and how changes in climate have created distinct biomes around the world. Through case studies of a range of contrasting locations, students will learn how people have adapted to these differing climate factors.
Our changing climate	Students will understand how world climates fluctuate and how recent human activity has affected this process. They will investigate the causes, effects and responses to our changing climate.
A Sustainable future?	Students will explore the pressures our growing population has on food, water, energy and land. They will evaluate the options available to manage these resources sustainably to provide the best quality of life for future generations.
Our future in the UK	Students will assess how major changes in the economy of the UK have affected and will continue to affect employment patterns and regional growth. They will become familiar with the different industries within the UK and how globalisation has affected the livelihoods of people in different parts of the UK.
Coasts	Students investigate how different processes create different coastal landforms such as headlands and bays. They will evaluate how different management strategies can reduce the impact of coastal erosion. They will develop interpretation and analytical skills through fieldwork based on Eastbourne's coastline.
