Maths Ambassadors

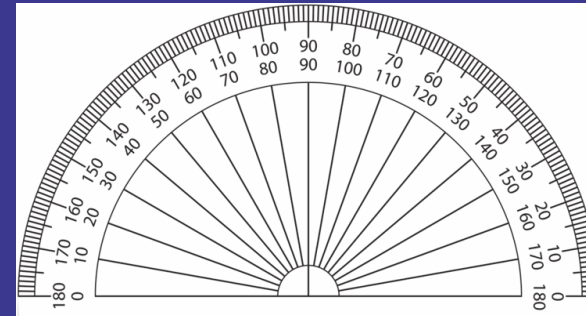
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- We will be choosing our maths ambassadors and they attend a weekly club.
