**How we have spent/ intend to spend the grant:**

1.	Year 6 into 7 Transition Summer School – 2 weeks August 2020	£7,920

3.	Year 10 Lesson 6 – After School Catch up Catch up this academic year	£14,000
4	Provision of laptops for remote learning	£5,000
5.	Staffing costs- catch up literacy, numeracy, and oracy support for Y7 and Y8.	£30,000
6	Additional resources to support additional literacy content in subjects.	£10 000

**How will the impact be measured?**

- Good attendance to remote learning in all year groups
- Indicators of rapid progress in addressing literacy deficit post transition in Y7 and Y8
