



Subject Vision

The aim of the MFL curriculum at Ratton School is for pupils to develop respect, understanding and appreciation of the foreign language-speaking culture through study of its language. This will involve the ability to communicate confidently in the language through both writing and speaking. The ability to also understand the written and aural form of the language will be integral to learning.
