Pupil Premium - An Explanation

As you read through the booklet, you will notice that the courses have different costs for students who are eligible for the Pupil Premium grant. As with all trips during the school year, Pupil Premium funding is used to subsidise activities, reducing the cost for disadvantaged students. This allows students to access opportunities that they might not otherwise have the chance to be involved in.

Each course has been given a percentage subsidy and this differs between each course as this is based on the relative benefit of each activity. For example, a course which has more potential to benefit a child's academic achievement or personal development will receive a higher subsidy than other, less academic, courses.


Day 1: We will be at Bushey wood trying out climbing, bouldering, archery and shelter building. This will take place in the forest.

Day 1 - Learn about the history of the town of Boulogne-Sur-Mer as well as learning French speaking skills needed for the trip.


Day 2 - Try some French cooking as well as continuing to practice French speaking skills.

We will also be covering a section on stable management and what the role of a farrier is. You don't have to already be able to ride and can join in at any level you are currently at, whether you have never sat on a horse before or compete at a high level.

Day 1 – **Journal making**. You will be making a Journal to hold an A6 note pad with a pocket for additional note cards. You will use patterned paper to cover the greyboard and learn how to create a professional look!

Day 2 – **Mixed media**. You will use mixed media techniques to decorate an A5 size wooden box. You will add texture and pre-cut shapes before adding a layer of powertex to make the decoration more hardwearing. The box will then be decorated with acrylic paint and dry brushing techniques. (look at the guitar in room 217 to see similar mixed media effects with powertex).

Day 3 – **Cardmaking**. You will create some cards using iris folding techniques; a technique which uses folded paper behind a pre - cut shape. You will follow a pattern and use patterned paper to enhance the final look of your card.

This is perfect for students who have a love of the outdoors and exploring the countryside. Students will be challenged to hike 50km in just 3 days, starting from Brighton and finishing at Ratton School on the final day. Tough climbs will be rewarded with stunning views of the South Downs and its surrounding human and physical landscapes.

Students will complete the hike in three stages with return transport from Ratton each morning and evening from the start and end points.

NB: The cost for this course is used to cover transport to the start point each day.
