KEY FACTS:

This course is not a GCSE but a Level 1-2 Vocational award that is graded from a Level 1 Pass up to a Level 2 Distinction*. The course is recognised by colleges/further education settings, and you gain equivalent points depending on your result.

This course is a popular choice at Ratton and students achieve good results.

This course is made up of 2 units:

Unit 1 (Year 10)- The Hospitality and Catering Industry. Theory work leading to a written exam worth 40% of the final grade. You sit the exam at the end of Year 11.

Unit 2 (Year 11) – Scenario based course work project with practical cooking exam – 60% of the final grade

This course is designed to develop your practical cooking skills, as well as to give you an understanding of how the Hospitality and Catering industry works at different levels.

From the restaurant brigade to housekeeping. Management positions to the kitchen brigade. We will look at the skills needed to become a variety of different roles within the industry. Any of these job roles can give you a full-time job with excellent career opportunities, if you work hard enough!
