Term	Module Title	Module Overview
1	Extreme Environments	Students will be inspired to discover more about the planet's more extreme environments, learning about the physical and human processes that have resulted in these landscapes. They will also investigate how managing hazard risk has allowed people to cope with living in these challenging landscapes.
2	Urban issues in Rio	Students will develop an understanding of the factors that produce a diverse variety of human environments; the dynamic nature of these environments that change over time and place; the need for sustainable management; and the areas of current and future challenge and opportunity for these environments.
3&4	Unfair world	Students will explore how development is about improving people's lives. They will discover the reasons behind global inequality and ways development can be measured. They will evaluate strategies used to close the development gap.
5&6	GCSE: Living world	Students will discover how the components of an ecosystem interact on a variety of scales. They will investigate the large scale ecosystems in rainforests and cold environments and the threats and opportunities of development in these areas.
